WE INVITE YOU to participate in one or more of our Workshops. Various units of study have been designed to enrich the academic social and emotional growth of the student. Please note the dates and fees of each workshop. All workshops will be held at Rocky Ridge Elementary School from 8 – 12.

- **Writing Workshop– June 1-5, \$125**
Focus on refinement and mechanics of writing through poetry, story writing, research writing, and more.
- **Book Club– June 1-5, \$125**
Join our book club related to interesting books. Students will engage in self – selected readings and collaborative reading during this workshop. Dialogue and reflective journals will be used to build comprehension strategies.
- **Math Enrichment– June 8-12, \$125**
Focus on problem solving and critical thinking.
- **Making Movies with the Computer- June 8-12, \$150**
Students will use Windows Movie Maker - part of the XP operating system, to make movies that will consist of video, pictures, and text. Students will learn how to shoot video, take pictures, and import them into the Movie Maker Program. Student will also gain exposure to other video and image editing software.
- **Writing Workshop- June 15-19, \$125**
Focus on refinement and mechanics of writing through poetry, story writing, research writing, and more.
- **Science/Nature Workshop- June 15-19, \$125**
Explore native plants and animals found in our community.
- **Math Enrichment– June 22–26, \$125**
Focus on problem solving and critical thinking.
- **Making Movies with the Computer- June 22-26, \$150**
Students will use Windows Movie Maker - part of the XP operating system, to make movies that will consist of video, pictures, and text. Students will learn how to shoot video, take pictures, and import them into the Movie Maker Program. Student will also gain exposure to other video and image editing software. (Limited enrollment.)
- **Chess– July 6-10, \$100**
Learn or refine the strategic game of chess.
- **Ultimate Exploration– July 6-10, \$125**

Children's Creative Learning Center Programs

Enrichment and reading programs for students ages 4 through grade 3 and workshops for ages 10-12 will be offered at Rocky Ridge Elementary School from 8 a.m. until noon. Fees, times, and subjects vary. See schedule on back of registration form for more information. Registration will be handled by UAB School of Education, (205) 934-8358 between the hours of 9 a.m. and 3 p.m.

Enrichment Program@\$125 weekly: Children participate in hour-long workshops centered around all curricular areas. Children ages 7-9 will select 4 workshops of interest per week. Children ages 4-6 participate in workshops as a group. See sample schedule below.

Enrichment Program with reading@\$150 weekly. Children attend 2 hours per day of intensive literacy instruction, along with 2 hour-long enrichment workshops. Individualized instruction will be based on administered assessments. See sample schedule below.

Reading Camp Only@\$100 weekly. Children attend 2 hours (10am-12pm)of intensive literacy instruction. Individualized instruction will be based on administered assessments.

Workshops for 10-12 year olds: Fees, times, and topics vary. See schedule on back of registration form for more information.

Afternoon Care: Afternoon care will be offered from 12:00-6:00 at Rocky Ridge Elementary School. The cost will be \$85 per week for 1 child, \$125 per week for 2 children, \$145 per week for 3 children and \$165 per week for 4 children. For more information and to register please call Debra Carrol between 8:00-4:30, Monday through Friday at 439-2864. Afternoon Care payment is due in advance and is non-refundable. Registration deadline for afternoon care is May 1, no exceptions. Afternoon Care is only available for children ages K - 5th grade.
